A: A short way is to use length, and a longer one is to use count which is defined in Data.List. length [1,2,3,4,5] > 5 count [1,2,3,4,5] > 3 A: As I remarked in a comment, you can write a function that solves your problem by counting each element from the head: countElements :: Eq a => a -> [a] -> Int countElements x [] = 0 countElements x (y:ys) = 1 + countElements y ys See all the well-known patterns and the use of "context" (y:ys) in my solution. Note: this is not as efficient as @Bob's answer.
